Elwood Town Council Meeting June 14, 2022

ADMINISTRATION

Councilmember Hardy gave the prayer Pledge of allegiances Councilmember Goodliffe and Pace was absent

Councilmember Lay made a motion to open the Public Hearing. Councilmember Hardy seconded the motion. The voting was unanimous in favor of the motion.

Mayor Nelson welcomed everyone to the meeting, Mayor Nelson reported on the 2021-2022 Revised budget and the 2022-2023 operating budget. Mayor Nelson reported regarding the revised budget, we went over on the road budget due to the emergency bridge on 8000 North.

Mayor Nelson reported on the 2022-2023 operating budget, Mayor stated we are budgeting \$10,000 for tile drains, the lines affect everyone in town. Councilmember Lay asked what the expenses were on the roads. Mayor Nelson stated we budgeted to fix the road at the park, 5600 west and we had to budget the \$60,000 for the loan payment for the bridge. Mayor Nelson explained we had to budget more for the Parks and Cemetery for the water we use. Mayor Nelson reported that we gave Gina and Steve a raise and we had to budget for a helper for Steve. Mayor Nelson stated that the loan payment for the water is \$111,000 and the sewer loan is \$46,000. Because of the depreciation, it looks like the water account is in the red, but we are in good shape.

Mayor Nelson asked if there was any public comment, but there was none.

Councilmember Lay made a motion to close the Public Hearing. Councilmember Hardy seconded the motion. The voting was unanimous in favor of the motion.

Councilmember Hardy made a motion to open the public meeting. Councilmember Lay seconded the motion. The voting was unanimous in favor of the motion.

Minutes for the June 14, 2022 town council meetings were presented for approval.

Councilmember Hardy made a motion to approve the minutes for June 14, 2022. Councilmember Lay seconded the motion. The voting was unanimous in favor of the motion.

Item#2 Resolution 2022-003 operating 2022-2023 budget, Mayor Nelson asked the council if they had any questions regarding the budget, but no one had any questions.

Item#3 Resolution 2022-004 revised 2021-2022 budget, Mayor Nelson asked the council if they had any questions regarding the revised budget, but no one had any questions.

Councilmember Hardy made a motion to approve the preliminary SafePro subdivision. Councilmember Lay seconded the motion. The voting was unanimous in favor of the motion.

Item#5 JC Minor Subdivision-Final Plat-Mark Hirschi presented the subdivision to the Council. He stated that they are keeping JC as a restaurant and the parking lot the same for now. Mayor Nelson stated that the planning commission recommended the 2-lot subdivision to the town council.

Councilmember Hardy made a motion to approve the JC final subdivision. Councilmember Lay seconded the motion. The voting was unanimous in favor of the motion.
